Fast track facts

- › Transit manages 10,900 kilometres of state highways and motorways in New Zealand, providing a strategic link to 80,000 kilometres of local roads.
- › The state highway network is a national asset valued at \$14.9 billion.
- › There are over 18 billion vehicle kilometres travelled per year on New Zealand state highways.
- › State Highway 1 immediately south of Auckland is the busiest road in New Zealand, carrying over 200,000 vehicles a day.
- › The World Bank uses Transit's operating structure as a benchmark for international best practice.
- › Transit leads the world in environmental roading initiatives, and has won the International Road Federation's Global Road Achievement Award for Environmental Mitigation three times.
